Brief History of Madrid United Methodist Church

In 1850, Reverend Mack Windham was minister for the people of the County Line United Methodist Church, which was located in Geneva-Henry County (which was later incorporated into Houston County). Reverend Windham led the people in the area to build a new church, and in 1903 began the life of Madrid United Methodist Church. The steeple was designed by a young man who sailed from Europe to Panama City, Florida he then traveled by train to Madrid. He spoke with Reverend Windham and volunteered to design the steeple, making it a very artistic attraction.

BUTTER COOKIES

3 c. sugar
3 sticks butter
2 egg yolks

Gradually cream 1 cup sugar into butter. Add egg yolks and vanilla. Mix well. Add flour gradually. Decide whether you want to use the dough in a cookie press, roll it out and use cookie cutters or slice cookies. Shape the dough accordingly. Refrigerate for 2 hours or until ready to bake. Preheat oven to 375°. Form dough into cookies, using whatever method you chose and place on an ungreased cookie sheet. Bake for 10 to 15 minutes. Don't let them get brown. Use spatula to remove and place on a rack to cool. When cooled, dip cookies in remaining sugar.

RICE CASSEROLE

1 lb. good pork sausage	2 pkg. dried chicken noodle soup mix
1 green pepper, chopped	½ c. rice, uncooked
1 small onion, chopped	1 pkg. slivered almonds
2 stalks celery, chopped	
4½ c. boiling water	

Fry sausage, made into bite size pieces, until done and pour off grease. Take sausage out and in the same pan, cook peppers, onions and celery until tender. Add boiling water, soup mix and rice; cook 7 minutes. Add the sausage and almonds; bake 1 hour uncovered at 300°.

RICE AND BROCCOLI CASSEROLE

2 c. rice, cooked	1 can cream of chicken soup
1 pkg. frozen broccoli, cooked & drained	½ c. milk
¼ c. onion, chopped	1 can water chestnuts, drained & sliced
3 Tbsp. butter	1 small jar Cheez Whiz

Mix all the ingredients except the Cheez Whiz. Place in a greased casserole dish and top with Cheez Whiz. Bake at 350° for about 1 hour.
